

LESSON PLANS

Title	
Lesson plan to be implemented in English class	
Aim	The main goal of this lesson plan is to provide an interactive and personal way for children to learn about themselves. Topic: "All about me"
Students age targeted	Fourth grade
Estimated time	45 minutes
Topics covered	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Discovering our inner self ● Embracing our uniqueness in our own way
Facility/ Equipment	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Classroom ● Internet access ● Projector ● White board
Tools/ Materials	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Worksheets, Books, Flashcards ● Stories, Listening tapes
Development of activities	<p>Activity 1: "Share in pairs"(10 minutes) students will pair in a group of two and share their likes, dislikes, talent and struggles in order to see how we all are different yet unique in our own way.</p> <p>Activity 2: "Describe yourself" (7 minutes) students will use nouns and adjectives to tell us about their appearance. In addition they will find similarities in each other, which will help with their dislikes.</p> <p>Activity 3: "When I grow up..."(3 minutes) students will fill up on the space they would like to take on in their future.</p> <p>Activity 4: "Express and impress"(10 minutes) the teacher will show worksheets on the white interactive board which show different emotions. Students need to describe them and show what type of emotion they feel at the exact moment.</p>



Activity 5: Wrap-up (10 mins) Teachers shows a sympathetic story of character from a movie on the white interactive board to help students when having trouble regulating their emotions and understating that sometimes it's okay not to be okay.

Task: Students should put the correct face expressions on the emotions shown on the board.

It's okay not to be okay





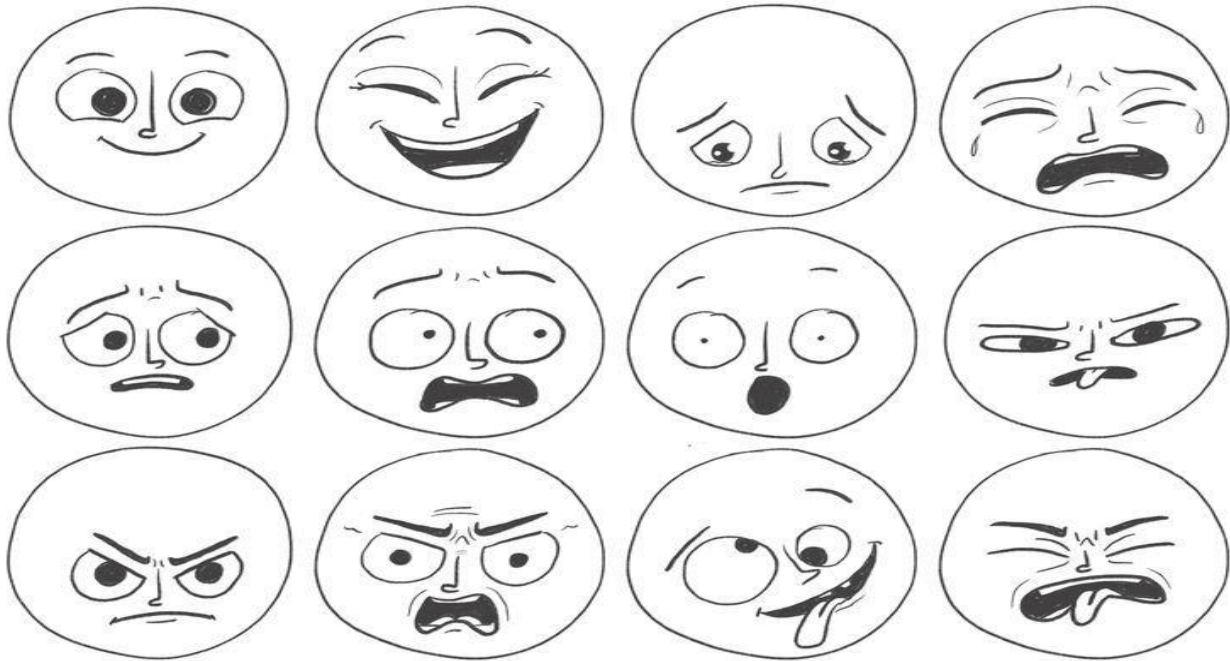
